1. IMPORTANT INFORMATION AND WHO WE ARE

Marshall respects your privacy and is committed to protecting your personal data. This privacy notice will inform you as to how we look after your personal data and tells you about your privacy rights and how the law protects you.

Marshall is the “data controller” for the purposes of data protection law in the context of this document. This means that we are responsible for deciding how we hold and use personal information. We are required by law to notify you of the information contained in this Privacy Notice.

This Privacy Notice describes how we collect and use personal information about you in accordance with the UK Data Protection Act & General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). In the context of this document we will either refer to you as, ‘you’ or the ‘data subject’.

2. THE DATA WE COLLECT ABOUT YOU

We may collect, use, store and erase the following kinds of personal data about you:

- Identity Data (including first name, postal address, email address) and your age group.

We do not knowingly collect any Special Categories of Personal Data about you (this includes details about your race or ethnicity, religious or philosophical beliefs, sex life, sexual orientation, political opinions, trade union membership, information about your health and genetic and biometric data). Nor do we collect any information about criminal convictions and offences. However in answering the questions you feel it necessary to supply any of this type of information to support your answer we will retain it for only so long as is necessary to assess its relevance and then delete.

3. HOW WE USE YOUR PERSONAL DATA

We will use your personal data for the following reason:

- Ensuring we are engaging effectively with the local community.

5. CONSENT

6. DISCLOSURE OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

We do not disclose your data to any third party.

7. DATA SECURITY

We have put in place appropriate security measures to prevent your personal data from being accidentally lost, used or accessed in an unauthorised way, altered or disclosed. In addition, we limit access to your personal data to those employees, agents, contractors and other third parties who have a business need to know. They will only process your personal data on our instructions (and with your permission) and they are subject to a duty of confidentiality and the laws & regulations managing Personal Data.

We have put in place procedures to deal with any suspected personal data breach and will notify you and any applicable regulator of a breach where we are legally required to do so.

8. DATA RETENTION

We will keep your data for so long as there is a requirement to process the data, once this requirement has ceased either at your request or otherwise we will delete your records from the system.

9. INTERNATIONAL TRANSFERS

Your data will not be transferred by us to any other country.

10. YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS

At any point while we are in possession of, or processing your personal data, you, the data subject, have the following rights:

- Right of access – you have the right to request a copy of the information that we hold about you.
- Right of rectification – you have a right to ask for data that we hold about you that is inaccurate or incomplete to be corrected.
- Right to be forgotten – in certain circumstances you can ask for the data we hold about you to be erased from our records. If there is no overriding legal reason to keep it.
- Right to restriction of processing – where certain conditions apply to have a right to restrict the processing.
- Right of portability – you have the right to have the data we hold about you transferred to another organisation.
- Right to object – you have the right to object to certain types of processing
- Right to object to automated processing, including profiling – You have the right to ask for certain important computer-made decisions (including profiling) to be challenged and to ask for a human to intervene.

(Please note that at this time no automated processing of Personal Identifiable Information (PII) is in operation).

in the event that Marshall refuses your request under rights of access, we will provide you with a reason as to why.

You have the right to complain as outlined in clause 11 below.

11. COMPLAINTS

In the event that you wish to make a complaint about how your personal data is being processed by Marshall, or how your complaint has been handled, you have the right to lodge a complaint directly with Marshall's Data Privacy Manager, by emailing DataPrivacyManager@Marcamb.co.uk or by sending written correspondence to The Data Privacy Manager, using the contact details below.

If the complaint is not resolved to your satisfaction you have the right to lodge the complaint with the Supervisory Authority.
